Qualified as a pilot in the South African Air Force in 1964.

Joined South African Airways in 1971 and from 1976 served for 43 years as a Training Captain on Hawker Siddeley 748's, Boeing 727's, 737-200's, 737-800's, 747 Classics, 747-400's, Airbus A300's, 319's, 320's, A340-200's, A340-300's and A340 -600's. During this period, up until retirement from Mango Airlines in June 2019, was also a SA CAA Designated Flight Examiner.

Trained through the era of mainly manually flown departures and arrivals, through the advent of more sophisticated automatic pilots, until the present day when almost all the control of the aircraft is automated.

Held various management positions, ranging from Training Captain, Fleet Captain, Fleet Training Captain, Head of Flight Standards and finally Chief Training Captain.

Championed projects amongst the Instructors to give specialist training in, for example, CRM, CFIT, AWOPS, PBN, RTO and ETOPS.

Has performed many solo and formation air displays in both Boeing and Airbus airliners.

Has 29 600 hours flying hours.
